Point To Ponder:

1. You can only live victorious when you lived convinced.
2. A double-minded Christian is a weak Christian.
3. Living unconvinced makes your life an emotional roller coaster.
4. A convinced Christian is a stable and productive Christian.

Read Romans 8:33-39

1. Overwhelming victory is possible.
2. Situations arise to separate you from that overwhelming victory.
3. We have to become believers who are CONVINCED.
4. There are natural and supernatural elements that come to distract and confuse you.

Discuss an event in your life that had you questioning your 'overwhelming victory'. How did you handle the 'doubt'?

Tell a story where you were 100% convinced that God's power was real?

If you don't have a personal story that convinces you - do you know someone who has convincing story of God's power? What is it?

Read John 21:1-12

1. After struggling all night Jesus proved He was God by giving them a miraculous catch of fish.
2. They were willing to throw their nets in obedience even though they has ZERO proof it would work. They risked trying something again that had failed previously.
3. Peter jumped in and swam 100 yds. to shore. He was convinced it was Jesus and he made no hesitation in making the move to get to Him.
4. Jesus convinced them by giving them a miraculous catch of fish and eating breakfast with them.

What area are you struggling in at present? Are you seeing God at work here?

Why does it seem so hard to trust God after you have seen failure?

Do you have any doubts that make you hesitate - Hesitate to GIVE, FORGIVE, TITHE, LOVE, OR GET OUT OF YOUR COMFORT ZONE?

What are your hesitations?

What would it take in your area of hesitation for you to become convinced that God's power will work on your behalf?
