Chapter Two

FAITH COMES BY HEARING: Read Chapter Two

SUMMARY: Verses 1-15

1. Teaching the bible is never to be haphazard. We should always teach sound doctrine, not just emotional and flippant ideas based around random Scriptures.
2. We are all to influence each other in accordance to faith.
3. Good leaders should always be influencing every generation in things of the faith.
4. Older men were to be spiritual examples to the younger generation. Likewise, were the mature women to be an example to the younger women.
5. We are encouraged to watch how we live. We are to live in such a way people have nothing bad to say about us even if they try to find fault.
6. Teaching is a key component of this chapter. Teaching others, teaching by example, teaching by doctrine, teaching by lifestyle, teaching by integrity.
7. Paul says we are to live in such a way that it makes the gospel attractive to those who aren't of the faith.
8. Grace is available to all and none are too far from grace to be touched and changed.
9. Grace isn't just Jesus overlooking our sins and failures. Grace teaches us to say NO to ungodly living.
10. Grace teaches me to be self controlled.
11. Jesus will return one day. We are to live in great expectation. Living for His return makes us eager to do good.
12. The only way we become Jesus' people is to be redeemed and purified by His sacrifice.
13. Part of the Christian leader's faith is not only encouraging but rebuking. We don't rebuke out of anger and emotion, but authority.
