The DNA Of God is RELATIONSHIP

1. CREATION: God's creative nature instills RELATIONSHIP.

- From the beginning of creation we see God's inherent nature of instilling relationship. God is, by nature, RELATIONAL. By His decision to name His creation and claiming it as "good" shows His willingness to be involved intimately with all His creation. (*Genesis 1:1-25*)
- All creation carries the DNA of God's relational nature. (*Romans 8:19-23*)

2. MANKIND: God's intentional language is RELATIONSHIP.

- God makes another relational statement giving us insight into His heavenly nature. God states, "Let US make man in OUR own image, after OUR LIKENESS." (*Genesis 1:26-27*)
- Inside every human being resides God's relational DNA. Every human has within their DNA the need for relationship. You are birthed out of and intended for relationship. (*Genesis 2:18-25; 4:1-2*)

3. REBELLION: God's intent was destroyed through BROKEN RELATIONSHIP.

- God was not just after relationship, but RIGHT RELATIONSHIP - that of a FATHER.
- Sin and rebellion broke the bond of that relationship. (*Genesis 3*)

4. RESTORATION: God's redemptive plan was the RESTORING of RELATIONSHIP.

- Every story in the bible testifies to the truth and nature of God's relational nature.
- The promised seed, the 10 Commandments, the wilderness wandering, the tabernacle, and the establishment of Israel as a nation are all reflections of God's relational nature.

5. REMEDY: God CONNECTED with us to REMEDY the problem of broken relationship.

- God came to humanity as a human - Jesus - to reestablish relationship. (*John 1*)
- Jesus was the remedy to a broken relationship with God. (*John 14*)
- The whole intent of Jesus' work was to bring all creation back into relationship with the heavenly Father. (*John 17*)

6. RECONCILIATION: The END RESULT is RELATIONAL restoration.

- **The MESSAGE OF THE CHURCH:** "You have been made right with God through Jesus." (*2 Corinthians 5:11-21*)
- **The MESSAGE OF OUR LIVES:** "Love God, love your neighbor as yourself." (*Luke 10:25-37*)

An important goal, purpose, or charge that is accompanied by strong conviction; a calling or vocation.

- Our Mission

- **WE ARE RELATIONAL:** Because our philosophy holds that **God is relational**, everything we do is done so that others can **encounter Jesus**. The goal of encountering Jesus is to birth an authentic faith that results in a life of **relationship** (*reconciled*), **discipleship** (love of God), and **mission** (love of others.) The END RESULT of all we do is RELATIONAL restoration. When others encounter Jesus we are successful.

- **LOVE**

LOVE has come to provide **NEW LIFE**. Jesus has been working for you, and He has plans and purposes for your life. God desires to adopt you and call you His own, fill you and work in you, and grow you so that you will reflect the true image and nature of Jesus and be the message of that relationship to others. You are designed to love God and be the display of His power to those around you. You have a story to tell so that others may know His love. (*Jeremiah 29:11-13; Romans 5:1-11; 8:14-31; 2 Corinthians 5:11-21*)

The love of Jesus is the answer for NEW LIFE.

- **POWER**

POWER has come to help us **LIVE LIFE**. Before Jesus left this earth, He left us a clear and concise plan of action. He gave us the gift of the Holy Spirit to be our **HELPER** in this life. We have been given power to overcome and succeed in this life. Through the Holy Spirit we have been gifted to live life and we are privy to the wisdom He offers as we carry out our divine purpose. (*John 14-17; Philippians 2:13; Acts 1:8; 2:1-4; Ephesians 1:15-23; 2:8-10; 3:14-21*)

The power of the Holy Spirit is our greatest resource for LIVING LIFE.

- **COMMUNITY**

COMMUNITY is all about **KINGDOM LIFE**. You were never designed to do life alone. You are designed to love and serve others. You are purposed to be part of a body and do life with other believers. You were created for community. Community is the avenue through which **GOD WORKS THROUGH YOU** so you can grow, mature, and be equipped for life in the church and the marketplace. (*Ephesians 4:1-16; I Corinthians 12; I John 1*)

Community equips you for kingdom work in the marketplace.

The BIG 10

- **We Gather To:**

1. **Fellowship:** Fellowship is the cornerstone of relationship. It is a reflection of being baptized into the body of Christ. It is through fellowship we all recognize the forgiving, healing, restoring, reconciling, and redeeming nature of Jesus Christ. *(Hebrews 10:25; I John 1:6-7)*
2. **Worship:** Worship is a key component of relationship. We sing to celebrate and make invitation for God's presence to invade our atmosphere. *(Psalm 95:1-6; Matthew 26:26-30)*
3. **Give:** We are called to give of ourselves, our talents, our time, and our finances. It is our belief that relationship is impossible without giving. We can never out-give God. *(Genesis 14:17-24; Luke 6:37-45; John 3:16; 6:1-13; 2 Corinthians 9:6-13)*
4. **Serve:** You've been given gifts and talents so that you may love others and help others encounter Jesus. You are valuable and uniquely qualified to serve others. *(I Corinthians 12; Galatians 5:13-26; Ephesians 4:15-16)*
5. **Hear and Respond:** Each time we gather as a congregation it is to hear and respond to a Word from the Spirit of God for our lives. Hearing and responding are the highest responses of relationship. In every service we make room for the presence of God to speak to us for healing, encouragement, repentance, and salvation, and we respond. *(Acts 2:37; Revelation 2-3)*
6. **Anoint:** We are structured as a church body with Elders who are appointed to serve, teach, lead the church, and anoint the sick with oil for healing. *(James 5:14-16)*
7. **Celebrate:** We believe the things that separate the church from any average business organization is our command to celebrate the sacraments: salvation & repentance, baptism, communion, marriage, and anointing the sick. These sacraments reflect a life that has encountered with Jesus and is walking in right relationship to His will. *(Acts 1:5; 2:41; 8:36-38; I Corinthians 11:26; Ephesians 5:31-32; James 5:14-16)*

- **We Scatter To:**

8. **Disciple Others:** We are called to grow into a mature Christian, reflecting a life-change that is Spirit led and increasing in faith. Together we study the bible and grow in faith together. Making disciples declares **WE LOVE GOD.** *(2 Timothy 3:14-17)*
9. **Care For Others:** We care for one another in community. In community God will use your gifts to bless and meet the needs of others. In community we make sure no need is left unnoticed. Caring for others declares **WE LOVE OUR NEIGHBOR.** *(Acts 2:44-47; 20:28)*
10. **Reach Others:** We take the love of Jesus into the streets so others may encounter Jesus. Every BGroup sets their own mission and joins with the congregation to reach our city, region, and world. Outreach declares **GOD IS RELATIONAL.** *(Matthew 28:19-20; Mark 16:15)*
